

## Maintenance Mode for Magento 2.X Installation Instructions

Before using the Maintenance Mode Extension in your Magento 2 store, we strongly recommend creating a complete database and codebase backup.

#### Installation by Unpacking the Extension

- 1. (Recommended) Run a backup of the codebase and database
- 2. Login to your Magento Server with a user who has permission to write to the Magento file system. Navigate to your store's root folder
- 3. Unpack the Maintenance Mode module in your Magento root folder
- 4. Execute the following commands:
  - php -f bin/magento module:enable CustomerParadigm\_MaintenanceMode
  - php -f bin/magento setup:upgrade
  - php -f bin/magento cache:flush
  - php -f bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
- 5. Log into the admin panel
- 6. You will now see the Magento 2 Maintenance Mode Extension by navigating in the admin to:



Stores > Maintenance Mode > Adjust Settings

## Uninstall/Removing the Extension

Perhaps this module doesn't work for your Magento 2 site or you no longer have a need for it. In the past, users found out the hard way that once a module or extension is installed, it's next to impossible to remove it from your system. Magento 2 does not have a fully defined mechanism to completely uninstall an extension. We've made it easy to remove the extension.

#### To uninstall the Magento 2 Maintenance Mode Extension, please follow these steps:

It is very important that before adding or removing anything from your Magento environment you create a complete database and codebase backup. This will ensure that all of your files will be protected and accessible should the uninstall not be performed correctly.

- 1. Create a backup of the codebase and database (Recommended)
- 2. Login to your Magento Server with a user who has permission to write to the Magento file system. Navigate to your store's root folder
- 3. Enter the following command:
  - | php -f bin/magento module:uninstall CustomerParadigm\_MaintenanceMode | php -f bin/magento cache:flush
- 4. To ensure the extension has been disabled, please navigate within the Magento admin to **System > Data Transfer** and make sure the Maintenance Mode link no longer exists.
- 5. You may now delete additional code associated with the extension (from your Magento root folder) located at: app/code/CustomerParadigm/MaintenanceMode

After these steps are completed, the extension has been completely removed from your system.
